Gifts under consideration

- Gymnasium improvements
 - Since auditorium isn't large enough, would like to be able to make the gym into a place where all McKenzie students can come together.
 - Wireless sound system for gym that can also be used in cafeteria for PTA meetings, possibly outside as well
 - Makeshift Stage for assemblies
- Creative learning space to replace reading deck outside
- Garden/outdoor improvements
 - Garden paths with stones/bricks in front of school and by kindergarten entrance
 - Improved drainage in front of school
 - Greenhouse
- Auditorium improvements – risers, sound system, seats, spotlight
- Donation of specific items for WJHS science facility
- Playground drinking fountain and/or filtered water drinking fountains inside
- Recess improvements – indoor recess options, outdoor ice skating rink, roller skates
- Drama club and/or school chorus – as recess or enrichment options?
- Cafeteria improvements – additional table, so
- lid covering so trays are less likely to flip in service line, lids/covers for hot food
- Integrated wellness program for kids incorporating exercise, nutrition, etc. could encompass organic milk and other organic lunch options (e.g. Organic Life or Gourmet Gorilla)
- Increase teacher stipends

The PTA Executive Board has decided to table the following items:

- Air conditioning – Cafeteria is too expensive to air condition; District has long range plan for A/C in the entire school
- iPads – This year the District is studying IPAD use in classrooms and considering iPads for all children. **We will have more information on this issue next year.**
- Nooks – Technology may become outdated
- Books – Book Fair provides books already
- Expensive items benefiting only a small number of students
- Updated equipment/supplies for 2nd floor staff copy room (color printer, laminator, paper cutter, organizational system/supplies)
- Wall Pads—The gyms have wall pads.
